

2022 Call for Applications – New Group Leaders BORDEAUX INSTITUTE OF ONCOLOGY (BRIC, INSERM U1312)



The BORDEAUX INSTITUTE OF ONCOLOGY (BRIC U1312, <https://www.bricbordeaux.com/>) is seeking to recruit new Group Leaders to develop innovative research programs on the biology and treatment of cancer. **Applications from both junior and senior scientists will be considered.**

BRIC is a newly established research unit in Bordeaux that is dedicated to cancer research. Its research program includes genetic and molecular oncogenesis, tumor heterogeneity and microenvironment, cancer cell metabolism, as well as delineating the mechanisms of resistance. BRIC unites 11 research teams and is currently located at two sites at the University of Bordeaux (Carreire and Talence campuses), with state-of-the-art core facilities available. To translate basic research findings, BRIC operates in close collaboration with clinical partners at the University Hospital of Bordeaux (CHU) and the Institut Bergonié cancer hospital. The applicant should have a strong track record to develop an ambitious project that complements the BRIC research program. Candidates should hold or meet criteria to compete for a French institutional research position (INSERM, etc.) as well as for national (ATIP-Avenir, FRM) and international (ERC) awards. Appointed Group Leaders will be provided with an initial support package including appropriate office and lab space as well as start-up funding.

PROCEDURE TO APPLY

Applicants should send a single PDF file (single-spaced, 11-point Arial) containing:

- Concise CV (1 page) and list of publications
- Project Abstract
- Detailed project description including objectives, rationale, and methodology highlighting the novelty and feasibility of the project as well as the added value to the BRIC network (4 pages)
- Description of past and present research and other related activities (2 pages)

Pre-selected candidates will be asked to provide a more detailed research plan and will be interviewed by both the selection committee and international Scientific Advisory Board of BRIC.
