







French-Finnish Renowned Scientist Conference Series Proposal

The Institut Français in Finland, the Embassy of France in Finland and the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation have partnered with the Finnish Society of Sciences and Letters and the Finnish Academy of Science and Letters to initiate and strengthen bilateral cooperation in science, innovation and higher education in fields of excellence in both countries.

The French-Finnish Renowned Scientist Conference Series program invites outstanding academics from France or Finland, from different disciplinary and research backgrounds, to participate in an open dialogue with their counterparts. The visit will include one major public lecture. In addition, the scholar is encouraged to participate in seminars, symposia or informal discussions with researchers/academics from the hosting coutry. It is expected that the visit will strengthen existing research partnerships and provide opportunities for building new research collaborations between scholars from France and Finland.

A grant of up to <u>1500 euros</u> will cover travel, accommodation and leaving expenses for a 4 to 7 days visit in the hosting country.

Selection Criteria:

- Proven track record of academic excellence and international recognition
- Innovative research with a view to interdisciplinarity
- Effective communication, outreach and access to the larger academic community and general public. A widely advertised public lecture, on campus or in partnership with a community organization, must be held.
- Potential for further scientific or other research collaboration

The selection committee is comprised of representatives of all the institutions supporting the grant.
